## Building Fundraiser Report

Get your shovels and hammers shined up and ready to go! On March 14, 2013, we received the word that the State Savings Bank of Marquette, MI approved our loan! This has been made possible by the generous donations from you, the supporters of the museum. We received a \$35,000 grant from the MCACA (Michigan Council for Arts & Cultural Affairs,) which made it possible for us to go for a loan through the bank instead of USDA, Rural Development.



We are able to keep the new payment as close as possible to what we are currently paying. We do want to let you know that we are borrowing \$200,000, which is the minimum we need to get the building up and open. This does not include a paved parking lot. This means we will continue to use the raffles and auction fundraisers for the New Building Fund. We sincerely thank everyone for making this a reality!! ## 1970 Timberwolf Returns to the Soo I-500 Track

On February 2, 2013, the 1970 Timberwolf, which was made in Sault Ste. Marie, MI, made a repeat trip around the I-500 race track! Only this time there were 50 vintage snowmobiles behind it instead of the race machines in 1970. It was an awesome finish to four years of doing research, from finding out there was

a snowmobile made in the Sault, to actually finding the Pace Sled for the 1970 race and restoring it, to actually having it make a lap around the track again. Many thanks go out to Larry Weinreis who was instrumental in the research, the co-founders, Dr. Tom Robinson & Professor Dick Zabelka, to David Blair who donated the machine to the museum, and to the restoration team of John Ketcher, Kurt Krause, Aaron Schroeder, Mark Williams and Charlie Vallier. Dr. Robinson even found two original, NOS tracks for the restoration. You can now see the Timberwolf in the Museum.


